Applications should be received by Tuesday 31st August 2021 and will be assessed by a small panel at a meeting to consider applications and you will be notified as soon as possible after this date. Weston BID may ask applicants for further details before making their assessment decision.

Criteria upon which applications will be judged:-

1. The project needs to take place within the BID area or drive footfall to the BID area.

Examples include but are not limited to:

- An event in your business premises
- Promotional material - for instance, leaflet promoting your business including Weston branding, flags, banners etc
- An improvement to your business frontage
- A digital improvement e.g. video (please note Weston BID already offers support to levy payers who require assistance with creating or developing websites)
- A project to improve a row of business premises, a street or a distinct area in Weston*

* Applications from businesses working together are encouraged and the grant available can be aggregated reflecting the benefits to more than one levy payer.

1. The project must have clear, measurable objectives.
2. The project should shine a positive light on Weston

Please note:

- If you grant is awarded, you agree to give permission for Weston BID to publicise the project in our marketing activities e.g. in a press release, on our website and social media channels.
- The application is made by a BID levy payer, who paid their BID levy in full during 2020/21.
- In the case of an event, public liability insurance must be held by the organiser.
- Organisations who pay more than one BID levy can only apply for one grant; however, the panel will take a view on the maximum amount that can be applied for.
- A second tranche of funds may be released after 30th July depending upon availability of funds.
